# 6 YEARS OF SUCCESS



Since our Plan began, Denver's Road Home and our partners have:

- Developed 2,373 new housing units
- Linked 5,817 homeless persons to employment opportunities and training
- Prevented 5,714 families and individuals from becoming homeless through eviction assistance
- Mentored over 900 seniors and families out of homelessness
- Housed 1,621 individuals through the Denver Street Outreach Collaborative
- Leveraged \$50 million in public and private dollars to accomplish these goals
